Starkwhite presents et al. at Art Unlimited, Art 39 Basel

We are pleased to announce that Starkwhite will present *altruistic studies* by et al. in the Art Unlimited section of Art 39 Basel from 3 – 8 June 2008. As announced at the end of 2007, we will also present a Dane Mitchell project in the Art Statements section of Art 39 Basel.

Art Basel is the world's premier international art show for modern and contemporary art, featuring leading galleries from around the globe and artists ranging from the great practitioners of modern art to the latest generation of emerging stars are represented in the show's multiple sections. 55,000 people attended Art 38 Basel, the last edition of this favourite rendezvous for the global art world, including artists, curators, collectors, art dealers and the world's art press.

Art Basel describes Art Unlimited as its "pioneering exhibition platform for projects that transcend the classical art-show stand – including video projections, large-scale installations, massive sculptures and live performances." An international jury comprising Victor Gisler, Xavier Hufkens David Juda, Tim Neuger, Claes Nordenhake and Esther Schipper, working with curator Simon Lamuniere, made the selections for this year's Art Unlimited.

Located in Auckland, New Zealand Starkwhite presents a programme of artists' projects, solo shows, independently curated exhibitions and occasional forays into new music and other interdisciplinary practices. We represent a stable of artists from New Zealand and the trans-Pacific region and also work with guest international artists, staging projects and exhibitions to enrich our programme and provide a context for the work of our artists who look beyond the edges of the New Zealand art scene, making art that is informed by and responsive to contemporary art made in other centres.
